FELT INSTRUCTIONS



FELT CARROT

INSPIRED BY THE STORY OF A FIERCE BAD RABBIT BY BEATRIX POTTER

YOU WILL NEED:

- ORANGE AND GREEN FELT
- ORANGE AND GREEN THREAD
- WADDING / STUFFING

INSTRUCTIONS (MAKES 1 CARROT)

1. CUT OUT THE TEMPLATES:
 - A. 1 TRIANGLE OF ORANGE FELT
 - B. 4-5 LEAF SHAPES OF GREEN FELT
2. STITCH OR DRAW LEAF DETAILS ONTO THE GREEN FELT LEAF SHAPES
3. FOLD THE ORANGE SHAPE IN HALF LONG THE STRAIGHT EDGES, AND SEW THE LONG STRAIGHT EDGES TOGETHER WITH THE ORANGE THREAD (A COUPLE OF MM FROM THE EDGE)
4. TURN THE RESULTING CONE INSIDE-OUT
5. SEW THE BOTTOMS OF THE LEAF STALKS TOGETHER
6. SEW A LOOSE RUNNING STITCH ALONG THE OPEN EDGE OF THE CARROT SHAPE, AND FILL WITH STUFFING / WADDING
7. STICK THE BOTTOM OF THE LEAF STALKS INTO THE TOP OF THE STUFFING
8. PULL THE RUNNING STITCH TIGHT AT THE TOP OF THE CARROT, KEEPING THE STUFFING AND LEAF STALKS INSIDE
9. SEW THE TOP CLOSED, ENSURING THE GREEN LEAF STALKS ARE SECURED



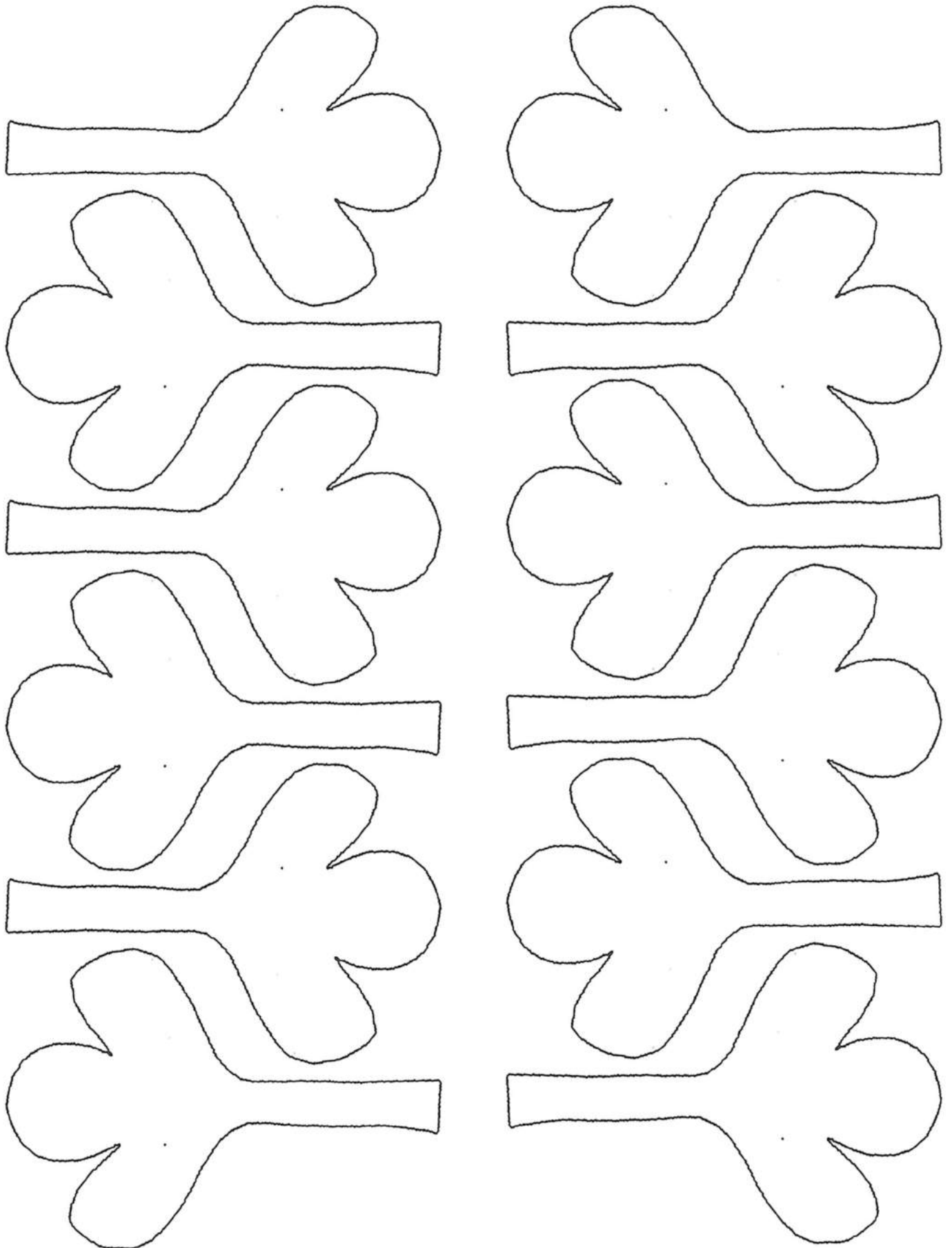
